RULES OF PLAY

1. The Number One Rule of the Burton Charity Classic Golf Tournament (BCCGT) is:

HAVE FUN!

Remember: All net proceeds from the tournament will be donated to the Semper Fi Fund (SFF) dedicated to assisting wounded veterans and their families.

2. The Tournament has two formats:
 - A. The first is **individual** play. A player competes only against those players in the same Flight.
 - B. The second format is a **four-man scramble** format.
3. **Individual** Play Flight Competitions:
 - A. The **Purist Flight** is for those golfers who eschew the use of play enhancing opportunities such as mulligans or free throws.
 - B. The **Needs-an-Edge** is for those golfers who could use a little help and can use up to six play enhancement opportunities during 18-hole endeavor.
 - C. The **On-The-Edge** is for those golfers who dream that they could shoot under if they had 12 play enhancement opportunities over 18 holes.
 - D. The **Over-The-Edge** is for those hackers that realize they need at least one enhancement opportunities over 18 holes to have a prayer of making the putt-off round for the tournament championship.
4. **Four-man Scramble** Flight Competitions:
 - A. There will be specials throughout the course that to your "Test" you team's Strengths....
5. Regardless of a player's flight, a player may use a maximum of only one play **enhancement opportunity** on any given hole. A play enhancement opportunity is a Mulligan or a free throw to improve one's lie.
 - A. A **mulligan** is redoing a shot/stroke with a club without assessing an additional stroke. If a player elects to use a Mulligan, the player must play the Mulligan ball for the balance of the hole regardless of the outcome of the stroke.
 - B. A **free throw** is used to improve a player's lie by attempting to throw the ball out of whatever trouble the player perceives himself to be in. All free throws, must be 'over-the-shoulder' throws where the player using the free throw has his or her

back to the green for that hole. If a player elects to use a free throw, the player must play from the thrown ball for the balance of the hole.

- C. **If a player uses** a mulligan or a free throw on any hole, please underline the score for that player on that hole.
6. **The Eagle has Landed:** On the specified hole, players in all flights except for those in **the Purist Flight**, will proceed to the designated area in the fairway. The player then takes their second shot on this Par Five from this location. No additional enhancement may be used on this specified hole.
 7. **Closest to the pin, Longest Drive, Longest Putt holes:** a cool prize will be awarded.
 8. **Inside the Circle:** land your ball inside the circle on any par three and get a sleeve of Semper Fi Saturday Golf Balls
 9. **Men** tee off from the white tees; **Women** tee off from the red tees.
 10. All Scoring **disputes** will be adjudicated by Mark Burton... unless of course the dispute involves his score. In that case, the dispute will be resolved either by ordeal or by Rick Parizek. In an event, and particularly by ordeal, the adjudication will be final.
 11. Play "**Ready Golf**". Keep Up with the foursome in front of you. Each player must hole out - no "gimmies" are allowed.
 12. The Last Rule:

HAVE FUN!

50/50 PUTTING CONTEST

All during the day, players can qualify to compete for the 50/50 Putting Contest. Half the money collected benefits the Semper Fi Fund. At the turn, try to qualify again....

Round One:

Sink one little putt and that qualifies you for the second round of the competition held after the tournament. Take as many putts as you want (up to 5 total): Before, During and After the Tournament (until round two begins).

Round Two:

Each Round One qualifier gets a chance to enter the Final Money Round. You have one opportunity to sink the putt and advance to the Final Money Round.

Final Money Round:

Each Round Two Qualifier will have a one putt opportunity to win up to 50% of the 50/50 money collected (estimated to be \$20 per player in tournament). Sink the putt and claim a part of the prize. If two or more qualifiers sink the putt, the money will be divided among the winners. If no one makes the putt, the closest to the hole will be awarded an appropriate amount of money.

All proceeds from the 50/50 Putting Contest benefit the Semper Fi Fund.

FINAL RULE:

The reasons you entered this tournament was to have fun and raise money to benefit the Semper Fi Fund, as they serve our injured and critically ill Marines, Soldiers, Sailors, Airmen and their families.

2	Closest to the Pin (Women) / Inside the Circle
6	Longest Putt / Inside the Circle
8	Closest to the Pin (Men) / Inside the Circle
9	Longest Drive – Ladies' Division
10	Closest to the Green – Men's Division
11	The EAGLE has Landed?
13	Closest to the Pin (Women) / Inside the Circle
15	Closest to the Pin (Men) / Inside the Circle
18	Closest to the pin (Everyone) / Inside the Circle
